

### **Healthy Communities Programs**

### Health & Well-Being Pillar

**Siembra Salud**, or Grow Wellness, is an at-home gardening and health initiative that uses horticulture as a catalyst to address comprehensive health behavioral and social needs. Trained staff and Health & Diversity Career Ladder interns help address and improve access to affordable produce in the Greater Omaha community. They also provide culturally influenced health and gardening education and programming.

**Club de Niños Saludables**, or Healthy Kids Club, focuses on preventing childhood obesity and promoting lifelong health, in a fun and engaging way, through nutrition education and physical activity following the 5-4-3-2-1 Go! curriculum. Activities include yoga, healthy cooking demonstrations, an annual Wellness University bootcamp and other activities.

### Additional Health and Wellness Health Community Strategies:

FCW enriches community health by offering culturally appropriate education, enrichment and on-site health services. These include community resource and awareness campaigns and distributions such as: mammogram screenings, flu clinics, Zumba classes, and our annual Women's Health Conference.

In order to build capacity within our greater community we also offer Spanish health trainings through Mental Health First Aid (MHFA), MHFA Youth, Hand-free CPR.

### **Social Integration Pillar**

**Civic Engagement** ensures our community is civically engaged by practicing their right to vote, building awareness of issues impacting our community, and making sure their voices are heard. Activities include: voter registration, outreach, and awareness, advocacy, and GOTV educational presentations and trainings.

**Bilingual Prime**, in partnership with Nebraska Humanities, Bilingual Prime Time engages parents and youth by providing enrichment opportunities through literature and discussion.

**Comunidades Fuertes, or Strong Communities,** brings community members and public representatives together to discuss, connect, and form better relationships through conversations and understanding of public services. Group conversations are held and resources are shared through six sessions with bilingual (Spanish-speaking) representatives from OPD, OFD, MUD, DHHS, and others.
